Messiah to the world. We know that the Apostles and the closest followers of Jesus met behind closed, locked doors on that first night following the resurrection; even after some had claimed to see Jesus alive and well.

Now, only a short time later, Saul has been granted permission from the high priest in Jerusalem to go to the city of Damascus, 130 miles (208 k) away, and arrest anyone teaching about Jesus Christ in the synagogues there. Damascus was just north of the far northern reaches of Israel and many of the followers traveled as far from Jerusalem as possible after the stoning of Stephen. Initially, the Apostles stayed in Jerusalem but even they ventured north in an attempt to escape the wrath of Saul.
