Building Project Updates

The Building Committee presented to the August 8th Board meeting, recommendations to move forward and enter into agreements with two separate contractors. One will replace our old boiler system with two new higher efficiency boilers, eliminating the need for the two electric water heaters in the boiler room, as well as installing a new programmable heat pump system of air conditioning for most of the church.
