Elders: Becky Canary John the Baptizer came from the wilderness to baptize a message of repentance and to proclaim the coming of Jesus. Just as many preachers today proclaim that Christ might return very soon, there were most likely many Jewish teachers who would say that Messiah was coming soon; not knowing what John knew.

But when some of the 'teachers of the Law' came out to repent, John was physically and emotionally upset because of their presence. It wasn't that he didn't want to be around them, but it was that he must not have wanted them to receive the forgiveness of God through baptism.


