Sermon 1/15 Sermon Series on S.H.A.P.E.

Experiences

2 Corinthians 12:1-5 Acts 9:1-9

Synopsis:

Probably by far, my most challenging class in seminary was that of Theology. The term comes from the Greek word for God, or Theos and the study of any subject; ology. It is defined as the study of the nature of God and religious belief. Notice that this doesn't say it is the definitive answer about God, simply the study of God's nature. It leaves the answer open to interpretation; just as God gave us the right to choose what we will do or be in life.

This week's sermon series lesson point is on experience and while I was in seminary, I understood that my life experiences helped me understand God's nature in my life. This would be called 'experiential theology.'
