Nope, Not That One

Ephesians 5:8-14 1 Samuel 16:1-13

Synopsis:

God had made up his mind as to who would succeed Saul on the throne as the first King of Israel. This was before the nation split into the Northern Kingdom, known as Israel, and Southern Kingdom, known as Judah. Samuel was the prophet that anointed Saul as king and now, God has called him to go Bethlehem to anoint one of the sons of Jesse.

Just as we struggle today to know what God is thinking when it comes to our daily lives, Samuel thought he know what God would be looking for in this next king. One by one, Samuel had Jesse present his sons, from the oldest to the youngest, before him as the prophet listened for the word of God to speak to him.
