#### Is This A Joke?

Isaiah 50:4-9a Matthew 21:1-11

#### Synopsis:

Jesus had told his followers, including the disciples, some time back – actually in Matthew 20:18-19 that reads - 'See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be handed over to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn him to death; then they will hand him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified; and on the third day he will be raised.'

He knew what he was doing and where he was going. He was going toward the cross. But when we think of Palm Sunday, we think of a time of celebration for Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

It might surprise you to know that the Roman Governor of Judea would ride into Jerusalem on this very day – every year. It was a planned event to show off the power of the Roman Government and to let the people of Judea know just who was in charge.

Jesus picked this very day to ride in from the east, rather than the west like Pontius Pilate, to show off his humility and willingness to be with the people, his people.
