## Sermon 4/23 Cup of Salvation

1 Peter 1:17-23 Psalm 116:1-4, 12-19

#### Synopsis:

God loved King David and King David loved God. David wanted to honor God in all that he did, each and every day. In Psalm 116, we find David asking himself – or basically asking God – how can we glorify you in a way that is pleasing to you?

David reflects back on the history of the Hebrew nation and the commands given by God when they were finally allowed to enter into the Promise Land. God told them how they should honor him. God told the Israelite people to bring a sheaf of the first fruits of the harvest, along with a lamb a year old, without blemish. He
