Sermon 4/30

Just Not Fair

Acts 2:42-47 1 Peter 2:19-25

Synopsis:

Peter is writing to remind his audience that they will endure suffering in life, it is just a part of what life is about. He also tells them that if they do wrong and they are punished for it by being beaten, then they are deserving of that punishment. If they live in a manner that is pleasing to the Lord and are beaten, even if what they did was the right thing to do, then God will consider that as a worthy lesson that is comparable to the suffering of Christ.

Jesus died on the cross on our behalf. That wasn't fair!
