The Journey

Sermon 5/14

Rand McNally

Galatians 5:1, 13-25 Luke 9:51-62

Synopsis:

There may be some much younger members of our congregation who have no clue as to what the title of this message even means. For those of us who remember life before we walked around with a phone, not to mention a high-powered computer/camera/phone in our pocket, we get it.

Most of us, back in the day, would never consider leaving the driveway on a trip that was expected to take more than an hour without a paper map that would be neatly folded up in the glove box in the car. There may have been times that it was as much of a challenge to refold that map neatly than to get to our final destination.

Oh, we could easily take off without that paper map and think, if I just keep heading south on whatever highway I find, I will reach my destination. That trip might include many more turns — and maybe a few turn arounds — than it should have taken. If we can't tell for sure where we are, geographically, then our intended course is difficult to determine.

In Luke 9:51, we are told that, "he set his face to go to Jerusalem" but we are not given any geographic identifiers to help us determine the path he took to get there.
