Sermon 5/21

Unexpected Turn

Acts 9:1-8, 19b-22 Acts 13:1-3, 42-47

Synopsis:

We continue our Sermon Series, The Journey, and what better person to know about a journey for God than Paul, the Apostle formerly known as Saul. He began his own journey, setting in motion his own plans and we know that those plans quickly changed.

Paul was quick to realize that God was behind his conversion event on the road to Damascus and it didn't take him long to transfer his fervent energy of persecuting the church to an effort to grow the church and serve God. Soon, Paul, along with Barnabas, set out from Damascus and made their way to Antioch.

Even with this new road map in front of him, there were unexpected turns along the way. Paul started his first missionary trip by preaching in synagogues to Jews in and around Antioch. God told Paul that he had different plans for him; plans to have him teaching the Gentiles all around the Mediterranean, starting churches throughout the region.
