# Double Portion of Forgiveness

Matthew 10:24-39 Romans 6:1b-11

#### Synopsis:

Paul is speaking to the church in Rome where some believers have apparently fallen into the trap of thinking that if they sin, they are forgiven, so if they sin more, they are forgiven more.

Well, we know that is not how forgiveness works and that teeters on the edge of testing God, in my humble opinion. That is not a good plan. To be forgiven is to be forgiven. There is not a quantity tag on that status.
