2 Corinthians 4:3-6

Let Your Face Shine

Synopsis:

The Gospel of Mark for this week tells the story of the transfiguration of Jesus on a mountain top where his clothes and faces shone brightly because of the presence of God. Those who were with him, Peter and James and John, were afraid when they saw the brightness of Jesus' appearance.

Paul tells the church in Corinth about how the gospel that Paul and his disciples preach can be veiled from being perceived. This would likely be a reference to Moses placing a veil over his face when he met God on the mountain top.

However, Paul is telling of the god (small 'g' i.e. Satan), of this world who has blinded those who do not know Jesus because Satan does not want them to be saved for eternity. Our job is to shine our light and our face into the darkness that is present around us to reach as many unsaved as possible.
