

Sermon 03/17

Among Those Who Went Up to Worship

Jeremiah 31:31-34 John 12:20-33

Synopsis:

Why does John believe it to be important to mention that some of those who were coming to the festival were Greeks? At that point in time, there would have been a group of new believers or some who were leaning toward a belief in Judaism who would have followed the command to be in Jerusalem for the three required festivals per year. And apparently, they have heard about this guy called Jesus.

Oddly enough, Jesus does not respond directly to this request from those who were Greek. Instead, he begins to tell the narrative of his approaching arrest. torture, crucifixion, and death.

Our reading for this week begins by referencing the fact that Jews were coming up to Jerusalem for the festival - the Festival of Passover. John is the only Gospel to mention that among those who went up to worship at the festival were some Greeks. These individuals Greek
