Sermon 03/24

Implausible Scenario

Isaiah 50:4-9a Mark 14:3-9

Synopsis:

If a playwright were to sit down to pen a play or short documentary about the anointing of Jesus as the Messiah, he/she might want to place the setting in unusual circumstances. You cannot get much more 'unusual' than our setting in this pericope in Mark's Gospel.

Jesus was at the home of a man named Simon who is from Bethany; the small town that sits about two miles east of Jerusalem. Jesus seems to use this village as a base-camp as he travels back and forth to Jerusalem during his last week of ministry on earth.

The only thing we know about Simon is that he is a leper. Does that mean that he is deathly ill or only mildly infected with some skin disease? We don't know but in the wide spectrum of skin diseases that are associated with leprosy, each would be considered contagious. Anyone with leprosy would be considered ceremoniously unclean, as would anyone who touched them.
