Sermon 4/21

I Shall Not Want John 10:11-18 Psalm 23:1-6

Synopsis:

In the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 25:31-33, Jesus tells us, 'When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left.'

Are you a sheep or a goat? I hope that you are a sheep. As we take a deeper look into Psalm 23, we need to look at this passage from the perspective of being a sheep. This was a metaphor that resonated with Israel at the time it was written.
