Sermon 4/28

Down From Jerusalem to Gaza

1 John 4:7-14 Acts 8:26-28, 34-35

Synopsis:

This passage from scripture that is a part of the lectionary readings for this week, jumped out at me because of the current event importance of today's world. May there be no political implications formed from using it. It is scripture. It is biblical!

In the reading, we find Philip, one of the Twelve, who was in tune with God's leading voice. He heard what God told him to do and he did it, not knowing why or what it was that he was supposed to do.

God used Philip's personal relationship with Christ — one that was much more than what ours might be — to be in just the right place to witness to this believer who needed to know more. Philip simply told him what he knew about Jesus and His ministry and that led the eunuch to be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ. Pastor Mark
