

Sermon 5/5

Even On the Gentiles

John 15:12-17 Acts 10:44-48

Synopsis:

Last week we heard about Saul approving and witnessing the stoning of Stephen and the continued in his persecution of the church around Jerusalem. He then carried his vigorous attack on Christians out to surrounding communities; heading toward Damascus in hopes of finding more of these who were turning against Judaism.

Just after Saul, now Paul, had been converted to become a believer of Jesus, he was intent on witnessing for Jesus as aggressively as he had been in his persecution. Peter had traveled to Lydda then Joppa to preach the Good News of Jesus.

This is where Peter and Cornelius each had like visions of meeting each other. Thus, Peter went to Caesarea to meet up with Cornelius along with his family and some close friends. Peter shared this same Good News to them, and they received the Holy
