

Deuteronomy 5:16 & Proverbs 22:6, 15 Proverbs 31:26-31

Synopsis:

Are you up for a challenge. For those who use a smart phone, go to Google and enter "translate." Select Hebrew to English, then tap the little camera icon to see what the title says in English.

Throughout the Bible, and particularly throughout the Book of Proverbs, we find numerous mentions and examples of God's love for us and instructions to help us live long, healthy lives. Proverbs often depicts a life of choosing between Wisdom and Folly. Folly is a loud, selfish, ignorant seductress while Wisdom is a stable, generous, intelligent friend.

Proverbs 31 tells of the words given to King Lemuel by his mother, a woman of great strength and wisdom, as she prepares him to live the life of a great king. While we know very little about Lemuel, it could be a pseudo-name for King
