Sermon 5/19

Labor Pains

Ezekiel 37:1-10 Romans 8:22-27

Synopsis:

This week's message might seem out of order as we just celebrated Mother's Day last Sunday and this week, we are talking about labor pains. Of course, every woman who is the mother to a child – or to children – knows that those labor pains must come before the beautiful miracle of birth of a child.

As we come to Pentecost. we think of the birth of what we call the "church" or Christianity. However, the term Pentecost comes from the Greek word meaning "fifty." The fifty comes from the Feast of Weeks which was a required pilgrimage festival for the Jews and was counted from the second day following Passover for seven full weeks or 49 days, The day following that would be the seventh Sunday after Passover or fifty days.

There are additional theological interpretations for the birth of the church, but we know we don't get to the birth without the labor
