#### **Sermon 10/22**

# The Cup of Praise

Exodus 6:1-7 Matthew 26:20-30

Synopsis:

Each week, while standing behind the Table of our Lord, I tell you, "Following the meal, Jesus took the cup, the Cup of Redemption, and having given thanks he gave it to them and said, "Drink from this cup, each of you." Then he told them, "Truly, I tell you, I shall not taste again from the fruit of the vine until I drink it new in the kingdom of heaven. Do this in remembrance of me."

That is my paraphrase of the Gospel stories on the institution of the Lord's Supper. Have you ever wondered why Jesus did not drink the fourth cup of the Seder meal? Did you know there are four cups for the Seder meal?

Jesus speaks to a future gathering around His Table in telling the Apostles that they will drink from that cup together in the Kingdom of Heaven. That is our hope for salvation. Pastor Mark
