Prophets in the Old Testament but the words he spoke should have given him the title of being one of the Major Prophets. He spoke the truth when other prophets in the area were speaking only deceit in order to benefit themselves.

In our reading from chapter 3, we see God using Micah to tell those other prophets – some of whom should have been called false prophets – just what will happen to them and it is not a pretty picture. In fact, the lectionary reading excludes the first four verses of this chapter because of the grotesque nature of it.

Not only do the words of Micah bring fear and trembling to those 'other' prophets but also to the house of Israel because he speaks of the destruction that will come to Jerusalem and the Temple of God. Micah tells these prophets that they will be banished to darkness, i.e. God will not speak a word to them. Pastor Mark
