

Sermon 8/11

Let's Get On With It

John 6:35, 41-51 1 Kings 19:4-8

Synopsis:

Our reading in 1 Kings picks up just after Ahab had told his wife, Jezebel, all that Elijah had done by killing the 450 prophets of Baal and she threatened Elijah saying, 'So may the gods do to me, and more also, if I do not make your life like the life of one of them by this time tomorrow.' This statement terrified Elijah and he headed out to Beer-sheba in Judah in fear of his life

Elijah had been prophesying for God for some time and was beginning to grow old and tired. After he had gone a day's journey beyond Beer-sheba,
