

#### John 6:51-58 Psalm 34:9-14

#### Synopsis:

Psalm 34 is a Psalm of thanksgiving, though it sounds more like a proclamation of God's power to inflict punishment rather than a way of giving thanks. Our psalmist has been the one who has gone through a difficult trial of some sort. He knows, firsthand, what God can and will do for those who call upon him

In giving thanks to God for rescuing him, he is also telling those who are still stuck in the fear of life's difficulties that there is a way out. God will provide that way out.

The psalmist sums up his proclamation with a reminder of how the people of God need to live. "Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit. Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it."
