

Sermon 1/26

The Firmament Proclaims

Nehemiah 8:1-3, 5-6 Psalm 19:1-14

Synopsis:

Our sermon scripture for this week comes from a Psalm of David. as King David is telling of God's beautiful creation and how God's love shines through all that has been created. He paints a beautiful picture of what a day even most days - in the life of the Israelites was like under the watchful eye of God Almighty.

From our celebration scripture, the first reading of the day, we see where Nehemiah, a governor of Persian Judea during the Second Temple period and also a Prophet of God, is telling the story of when Ezra, a scribe, had been told to bring the book of the law of 10:30 a.m. Worship Service
