called "Buffering." And "Voila"!

Buffering can mean a lot, right? It's that inbetween moment— waiting for something to load, process, or clarify. If we expand it metaphorically, it could symbolize life's pauses or transitions—those times when you're waiting for inspiration, growth, or the next step to take shape.

"Buffering" on a computer refers to the process of temporarily storing a portion of data (like video or audio) in a designated memory area called a "buffer" to ensure smooth playback, it preloads content to prevent stuttering or delays while streaming media like videos or music

From our Celebration Scripture reading, we find Joseph, the son of Jacob/Israel, preparing Egypt for a period of famine that will cause many to starve to death, if they don't follow God's plans outlined by Joseph in front of Pharaoh. He was storing up vital data or food supplies to help them survive.
